



International Student Admissions

Please note: **International students should contact the Admissions Office early in the year to allow enough time for all materials to be collected and legal documents to be mailed to the students.** All documents submitted to Admissions must be translated into English, no exceptions.

Admissions Requirements

- Each applicant must be at least 17 years of age at the time of registration.
- Since the College is a post secondary institution, each applicant must be a high school graduate or have obtained a GED diploma or have met the requirements of New York State regarding high school completion.
- Transcripts are required for all secondary and post secondary education.

Admissions Procedures (An I-20 will not be submitted until the following steps are completed)

- International students must complete and return the Application and Pastor’s Recommendation.
- Because the College is an English-speaking school, applicants whose first language is not English must take the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) exam and submit those scores to Davis using our institutional code 1000. Students must receive a score of 525 or better on the paper based exam and 195 or better on the computer based exam.
- Completed health forms and medical history documentation must be submitted.
- International Students wishing to transfer from another academic institution in the United States must also obtain a Transfer Eligibility form from the Admissions Office and have it completed by the student’s current Designated School Official (DSO).
- **Payment of a \$4180 (US) down payment must be made before an I-20 will be submitted.**
- **Payment of \$4180 or the balance of your bill is expected at or before Registration Day for each semester.**
- Up to \$750 may be earned per semester through the student work-study program and is subject to limited availability.
- If planning to stay for Optional Practical Training after completion of your degree at Davis College, you are responsible for all additional fees.
