JOHNSON CITY, NY (August 18, 2009) – Davis College will celebrate Homecoming September 24-26, 2009 with events designed to encourage alumni and friends through preaching, reunions and other activities. “For 109 years our campus has trained men and women for culturally relevant ministry around the world. Homecoming is an opportunity for us to minister to our alumni and friends and share the many good things happening at the College. The historic tradition of excellence in biblical higher education that began in Johnson City with the vision of our founder has expanded through churches and organizations worldwide and continues on the campus today. The annual Leadership Forum for Christian leaders will take place Thursday, September 24<sup>th</sup> from 9 AM – 3 PM. Speakers will be Dr. Dino J. Saturday, September 26<sup>th</sup> will begin with morning devotions and prayer followed by brunch. Homecoming activities will end with a Lady Falcons soccer game at 3 PM.
