Commencement 2020 Update

We are monitoring our ability to conduct commencement exercises daily. Current conditions have forced us to cancel face-to-face instruction, group gatherings, and close the school to non-essential staff. To date, the awards chapel has been cancelled. There is good reason to assume that graduation exercises will also be cancelled. The ultimate decision, however, will be determined by the spread and severity of COVID-19 cases in Broome County and across New York state. A final decision regarding Commencement 2020 will be made by Monday, April 20. This initial notice is for planning purposes for students and their families.

If graduation is cancelled, students will receive their diplomas, awards, and regalia by mail. Students will also be given the option to participate in next year's graduation exercises at our new Pottersville, NY location, pending all necessary approvals by the governing agencies. This means, that even though the graduation exercises may be cancelled, you still graduate. A public recognition of this achievement will be available at our new location as described above.

Students are encouraged to fulfill all the academic, financial, and administrative requirements needed to graduate on time.
